DESCRIPTION & OPERATION

Electric remote control mirrors are controlled by a dual-control switch mounted on driver's door, dash or center console depending on model. Left/right switch directs current to desired mirror. Horizontal/vertical switch directs current to electric motor in mirror assembly, controlling up/down and left/right adjustment. Heated mirrors are controlled by defogger relay.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

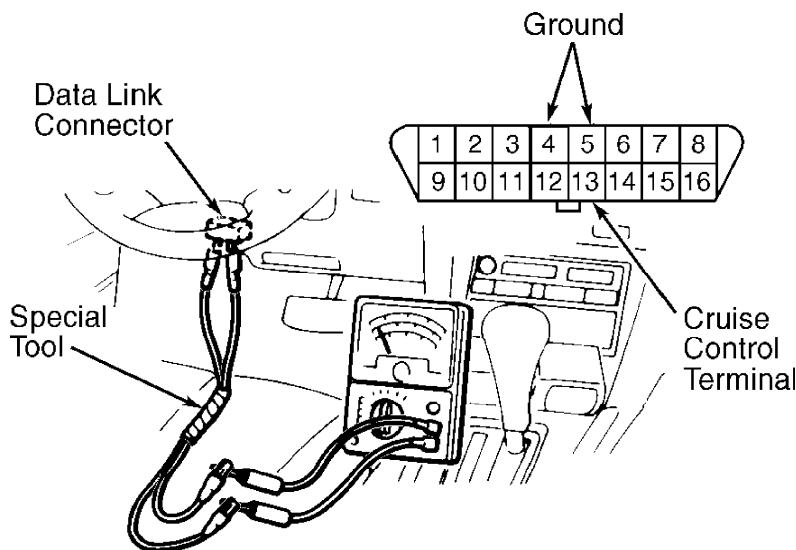
POWER MIRRORS INOPERATIVE

Check for faulty fuse, faulty power mirror switch or faulty power mirror motor. See POWER MIRROR FUSE IDENTIFICATION table.

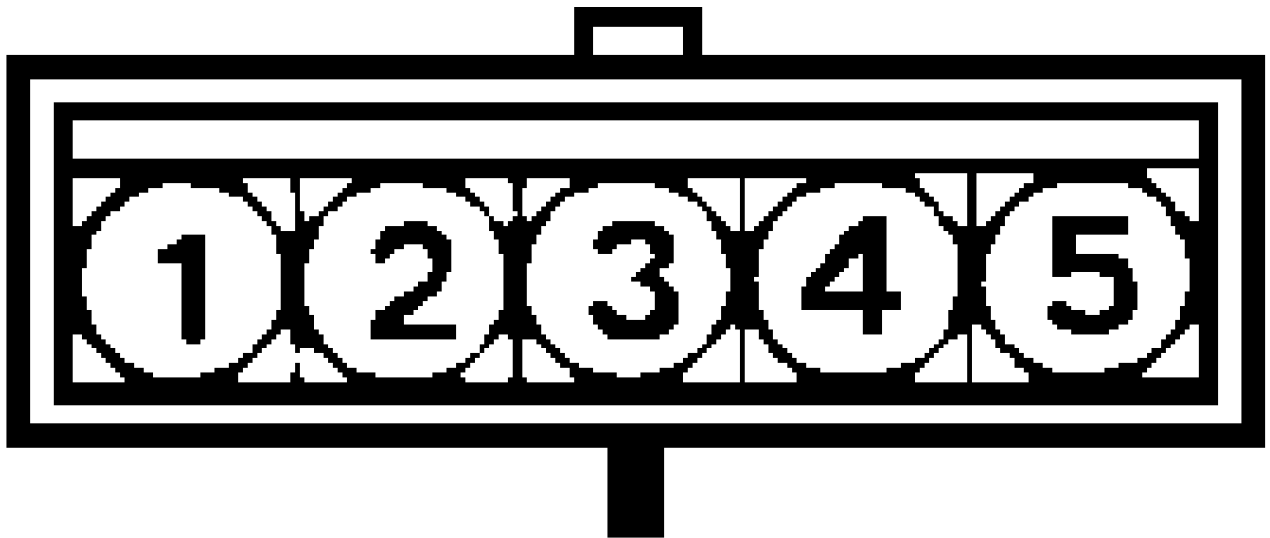


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Fig. 1: Identifying Data Link Connector Terminals

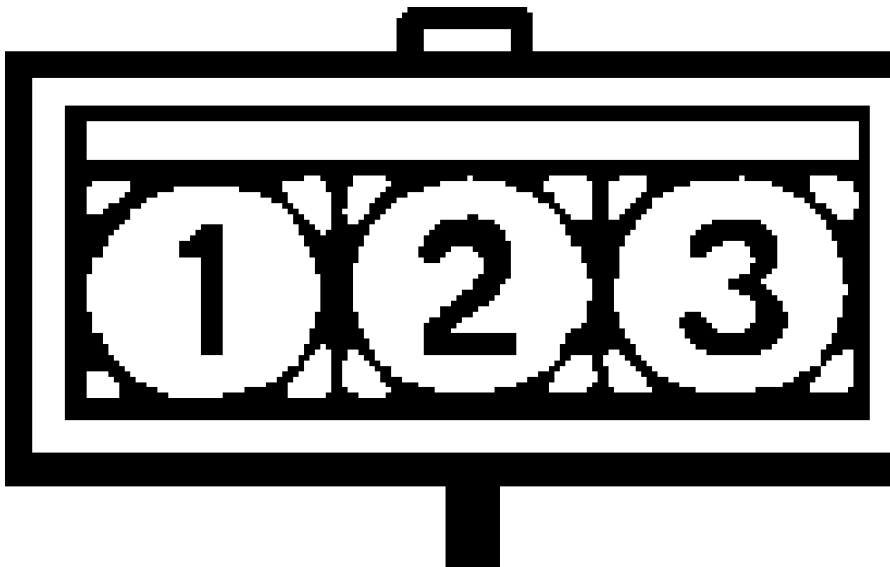
POWER MIRROR MOTOR TEST

Connect 12-volt power source to mirror connector terminals.
See Fig. 2 and Fig. 4. Replace mirror as necessary.




















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Fig. 2: Power Mirror Connector With Heater (Stealth & 3000GT)

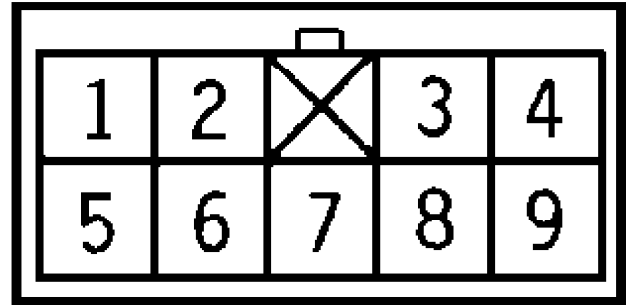
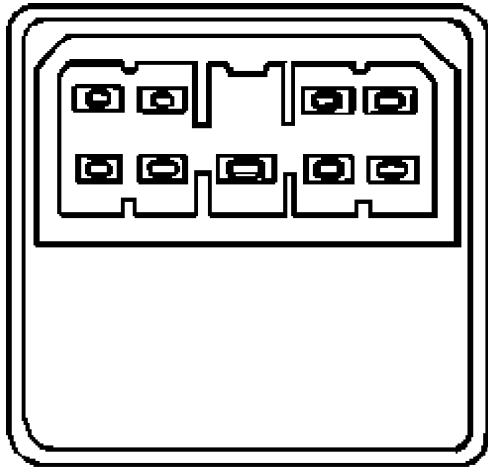
POWER MIRROR SWITCH TEST

Remove mirror switch. Using ohmmeter, check continuity of switch. See appropriate POWER MIRROR SWITCH CONTINUITY CHART. See Fig. 5. Replace switch if switch continuity is not as specified.

POWER MIRROR SWITCH CONTINUITY CHART

Switch Position	(1) Check Continuity Between
Left Side	
UP	Pins No. 4 & 8; Pins No. 6 & 7
DOWN	Pins No. 4 & 7; Pins No. 6 & 8
LEFT	Pins No. 3 & 6; Pins No. 4 & 7
RIGHT	Pins No. 3 & 4; Pins No. 6 & 7 Right
Side	
UP	Pins No. 2 & 4; Pins No. 6 & 7
DOWN	Pins No. 2 & 6; Pins No. 4 & 7
LEFT	Pins No. 4 & 7; Pins No. 6 & 9
RIGHT	Pins No. 4 & 9; Pins No. 6 & 7

REMOVAL & INSTALLATION

POWER MIRROR ASSEMBLY

Remove delta cover (trim cover), screws and electrical connector. Remove mirror assembly. To install, reverse removal procedure.

WIRING DIAGRAMS

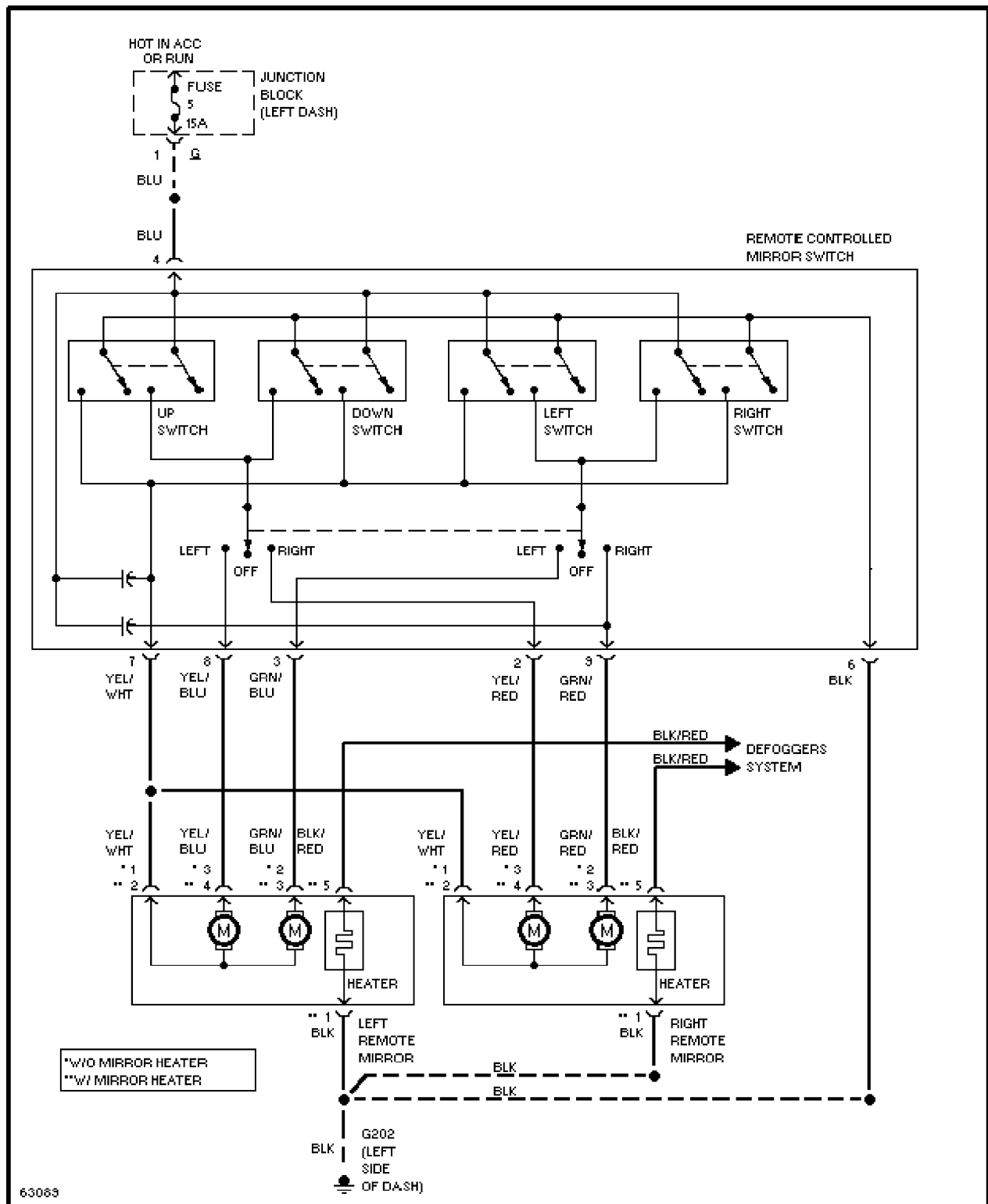


Fig. 6: Power Mirrors Wiring Diagram (Stealth & 3000GT)
